Dr. Gérard M. London graduate from medical school of Charles University in Prague in July 1966. From 1966 to 1970 he continued nephrology training and qualification in Paris Necker Hospital (Prof. Jean Hamburger) and Broussais Hospital (Prof. Paul Milliez). He became the chief of the department of Nephrology-Hemodialysis of the Manhes Hospital from 1970-2009. He was member of the Council of French Society of Nephrology and the Council of French Society of Hypertension (1994-2001), and member of the Council of International Society of Hypertension (2005-2012). President of ERA-EDTA (European Renal Association – European Dialysis and Transplant Association) from 2008-2011, he is presently the Chair of ERA-EDTA EURECAM (Cardiac and renal medicine) Working group, and Senior Scientist PARCC/INSERM Paris HEGP.

Member of International/American/French Societies of Hypertension, and Honorary Mem-

ber of the Czech Society of Hypertension, Dr London is Member of International/European/American/ French Societies of Nephrology, and Honorary Member of Czech/Italian/Slovak/Spanish/Polish Societies of Nephrology, and European Society of Cardiology. Dr. London was awarded the Gold Medal of Charles University Prague, Paul Milliez Award of European Soc. of Hypertension, Award for All live Scientific Achievement of ERA-EDTA, and Médaille Jean Hamburger from Société de Néphrologie. Dr.London is presently member of the Editorial Board of Journal of Nephrology, Nephrol. Dial. Transplant., Blood Purification, and serves as reviewer for Circulation, Hypertension, Circulation Research, Kidney International, Journal of American Society of Nephrology, Lancet, and several others.
