Konstantinos Tsioufis is Professor of Cardiology and Director of the First Department of Cardiology, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Hippokration Hospital, Athens, Greece. Professor Tsioufis works as an interventional cardiologist and hypertension specialist with >1.000 publications in peer-reviewed journals, H-index >86, and >80.000 citations. Professor Tsioufis was a post-doctoral fellow at the Veterans Affairs Medical Centre, Georgetown University Washington DC, US. His research focuses on the hypertensive, cardiorenal, and atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease and interventional cardiology. He has been involved as primary investigator in major clinical trials regarding novel inter-

ventional therapies for hypertension and particularly renal denervation. He is a fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (FESC), a fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC) and has been a member of the Task Force for the 2018 ESC/ESH hypertension guidelines, 2021 ESC guidelines on cardiovascular disease prevention and 2023 ESH hypertension guidelines. He has served as President of the European Society of Hypertension (2017-19) and President of the Hellenic Society of Cardiology (2016-18). Currently, he is Vice Dean of the Athens School of Medicine and President of the Hellenic Society of Hypertension.
