



## **Costas Thomopoulos**

Costas Thomopoulos is the Head of the Department of Cardiology in the General Hospital of Athens "Laiko", Greece. The main areas of his expertise related to hypertension are the design of clinical trials, meta-analyses of randomized trials, the interrelationships between sleep-disordered breathing and endothelial dysfunction, and the association of hypertensive disorders in pregnancy with adverse perinatal outcomes. Dr. Thomopoulos is a Clinical Hypertension Specialist at 1) the Hellenic Society of Hypertension, 2) the European Society of Hypertension (ESH), and 3) the American Society of Hypertension. He served as President of the Working Group "Hypertension and the Heart" of the Hellenic Society of

Cardiology (2018-2019), and currently, he is 1) a Council member of the Hellenic Society of Hypertension (2023-2024) and President of the ESH Working Group "Hypertension in Women". Within the field of hypertension, he received the ESH Talal Zein Award (2018) and the ESH Björn Folkow Award (2022). As an author, he contributed chapters in 9 textbooks relevant to Cardiovascular Medicine, including "Hypertension: A Companion to Braunwald's Heart Disease". He authored or co-authored 1) 200 full-text articles in peer-reviewed journals (h-index: 49) and 2) 370 communications in International Cardiovascular Medicine Congresses.
