**H**is main interests span from the prevention, detection and management of hypertension to the epidemiology of cardiovascular disease, to nutrition and health (with a special interest in the effects of sodium and potassium on cardiovascular risk), metabolic abnormalities, risk in ethnic minorities, both in developed and developing countries and sleep epidemiology. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians, Faculty of Public Health, British & Irish Hypertension Society, European Society of Cardiology and American Heart Association. He has been the recipient of numerous awards including the European Diploma of Hypertension Specialist, the 2002 RCGP and Boots The Chemists Research Paper of the Year Award, ISHIB Distinguished Researcher Award, the 40<sup>th</sup> Anni-

versary Gold Medal of the Lithuanian Society of Cardiology and the World Hypertension League Recognition of Excellence Award in Dietary Salt Reduction. He is the Immediate Past-President of the British & Irish Hypertension Society, which he served as Treasurer (2005-9), Executive Member (2009-12), Vice-President (2015-17) and President (2017-19). He has authored numerous national and international guidelines with NICE and the World Health Organization. He is Senior Advisor to the WHO for the design, implementation and delivery of national population salt reduction initiatives in several regions of the world. He has been Director of the WHO Collaborating Centre for Nutrition since 2008. He has authored over 500 publications in journals and books (h-index=88; citations 39,608).
